History of December 15

- ◆ 1953 : S. Vijayalakshmi Pandit of India was elected the first woman President of the eighth session of the United Nations General Assembly.
- ♦ 2003 : The Bhutan government started action against Indian separatists operating there.
- 1911 : Banaras Hindu University Society was established.
- ▶ 1961 : Adolf Eichmann, the organizer of the systematic massacre of Jews in the 1961 Holocaust by Nazi dictator Adolf Hitler, was sentenced to death.

Current Affairs Related to 15 December

- The Union Cabinet has approved additional allocation of Rs 2500 crore under the interest parity or subsidy scheme to provide the facility of rupee export credit before and after the shipment till June 30, 2024 next year. This step will help exporters from identified sectors and all MSME exporters to avail rupee export credit at competitive rates at a time when the global economy is going through adverse conditions.
- Indian Oil Corporation Limited and EKI Energy Services have come together to promote Surya Nutan, an innovative indoor solar cooking system developed by Indian Oil. The collaboration aims to leverage carbon finance and other sustainable tools to scale up the production, distribution and adoption of this eco-friendly cooking solution. Indian Oil, a Fortune 500 company with a major presence in India's hydrocarbon sector, has committed to achieving net zero carbon emissions by 2046.
- Swiggy, a leading online food ordering and delivery company, has taken a strategic step by appointing Anand Kripalu as Chairman of its Board and Independent Director. 
