History of December 31

- ♦ 1929 : Congress workers under the leadership of Mahatma Gandhi started a movement for complete independence in Lahore.
- ◆ 1984 : Rajiv Gandhi became the seventh Prime Minister of India at the age of 40.
- 1600 : British East India Company was established.
- ♦ 1802 : Peshwa Bajirao II received British protection.
- ♦ 2003: The foreign secretaries of India and other SAARC countries began talks ahead of the summit.
- ◆ 1492: 1,000,000 Jews were deported from the Sicily region of Italy.

Current Affairs Related to 31 December

- The Securities and Exchange Board of India has given its approval to the appointment of former Coal India chief Pramod Agarwal as the chairman of Bombay Stock Exchange. This regulatory approval paves the way for Agarwal to assume his role on the Governing Board of BSE, effective January 17, 2024. The move comes as the tenure of current chairman SS Mundra ends on January 16, 2024.
- Central Railway General Manager Ram Karan Yadav has said that panic switches will be installed at 117 railway stations. In his first press conference after assuming charge, Yadav said that Central Railway will install these panic switches at 117 stations of its network. Panic switch will alert Railway Protection Force personnel. In case of any emergency, passengers can press these switches to seek help from RPF.
- ♦ An important development was seen in the 16th Rajasthan Assembly when veteran BJP MLA Vasudev Devnani was unanimously elected as the Speaker. The proposal for his appointment was moved by Chief Minister Bhajan Lal Sharma and seconded by Congress leader and Tank MLA Sachin Pilot.
- Acclaimed Indian wrestler Sakshi Malik, bronze medalist at the 2016 Rio Olympics, announced her retirement in protest against the recent leadership change of the Wrestling Federation of India. This step has been taken after allegations of sexual exploitation against ousted President Brih Bhushan Singh and the controversial election of his close aide Sanjay Singh.
- Minister of Health and Family Welfare inaugurated SAANS Campaign 2023-2024 in Imphal, Manipur aimed at combating childhood pneumonia and raising public health awareness. Emphasizing the state's commitment to child health care, the Minister also dedicated the Jawaharlal Nehru Institute of Medical Sciences as the State Neonatal Resource Centre.

- The government's cautious stance of shying away from complete privatization is likely to result in missing the FY20 target. As the threat of imminent general elections looms, the government's privatization efforts have slowed, and caution is being exercised in view of possible accusations of selling off national assets. The ambitious disinvestment target for the current financial year is likely not to be met as major projects including Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited, Shipping Corporation of India and Concor have been put on hold.
- The Ministry of Rural Development has signed an MoU with Reliance Retail's JioMart to increase market access for products of Self Help Groups under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana National Rural Livelihood Mission. In a related program, Additional Secretary, Rural Livelihood Mission, Charanjit Singh said that with this tie-up, SHGs will be able to join as sellers on the e-commerce platform and will be able to deliver their products to a large customer base.
- The World Health Organization has issued a warning revealing that more than one million children in Afghanistan are currently suffering from severe malnutrition. This dire situation has prompted an urgent call for international assistance and funding, as countries attempt to deal with the growing crisis.
- ◆ Terminal 2 of Bengaluru's Kempegowda International Airport received global accolade at UNESCO's Prix Versailles 2023, being recognized as one of the most beautiful airports in the world.
