History of January 31

- ♦ 1561: Bairam Khan, under the patronage of Mughal emperor Akbar, was assassinated in Patan, Gujarat.
- ♦ 1599: On the orders of Britain's Queen Elizabeth I, Britain's first East India Company was established in India.
- 1963: The peacock was declared the national bird of India.
- ♦ 1983 : The first dry port started in Kolkata.
- ◆ 1923 : Somnath Sharma, the first Indian martyr to receive the Param Vir Chakra, was born.

Current Affairs Related to 31 January

- NPCI is continuously taking several steps to increase digital payments in the country. Now apart from India, payments can be made through UPI in many countries of the world. An agreement has been signed between NPC and Google to promote UPI payments. The MoU will enable Indian travelers to make payments in other countries through Google Pay. In such a situation, the problem of carrying cash or foreign currency while going abroad will end.
- According to the new guidelines announced by the Education Ministry, coaching centers cannot enroll students below 16 years of age, make misleading promises and cannot guarantee rank or good marks. The decision comes after complaints to the government regarding rising cases of student suicides, incidents of fire in coaching centers and lack of facilities as well as the teaching methods adopted by them. No coaching center will hire tutors with qualifications less than graduation.
- MPlands e-Sakshi mobile application has been launched by Rao Inderjit Singh. MPLADS e-Sakshi mobile application is for revised fund flow process under MPLADS scheme. The mobile app will provide convenience and accessibility to MPs. With this app, MPs will be able to propose, track and monitor projects at their fingertips. It enhances decision making processes and enables quick responses to emerging needs or issues. This will streamline communication between MPs and concerned officials.
- Houthi attacks on merchant vessels in the Red Sea could have a negative impact on oil importing countries, including India. Houthi rebels in Yemen have attacked commercial shipping vessels in response to the war in Gaza.
- ♦ China is facing a demographic crisis as its population is set to decline for the second consecutive year in 2023. The decline is due to a decline in the birth rate and an increase in deaths, especially after COVID-19 restrictions are lifted.

- L&T Construction's Railway Strategic Business
 Group has won a landmark contract worth Rs
 10,000-15,000 crore for a critical section of the
 Mumbai-Ahmedabad Bullet Train Project. The mega

- Samvesha Project launched by Indian Science, Technology and Engineering Facility Map. I-STEM is an initiative of the Office of the Principal Scientific Adviser to the Government of India, which plans to organize around 50 symposiums across India in 2024. The objective of the project is to connect researchers with scientific institutions through an online portal.
- The project of depositing artificial reefs in the sea bed was launched by Union Fisheries Minister Shri Parashotham Rupala through video conferencing at Vizhinjam, Thiruvananthapuram. This project is a joint initiative of the Central and State Government. Its objective is to increase the income of fishermen by increasing the fish population in the area. The project is being implemented under the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana with a total outlay of Rs 13.02 crore.
- Indian Army developed a complete secure mobile ecosystem. The Sambhav ecosystem works on state-of-the-art contemporary 5G technology. It has been developed in collaboration with national centers of excellence in academia and industry. It has been developed in line with the vision of self-reliant India in the defense sector. The initiative is an alignment of the government's vision of dual-use infrastructure and civil military fusion in technology.
- The 2023 Global Climate Highlights report was released by the Copernicus Climate Change Service of the European Union. 2023 has been declared the hottest year on record. According to the report, the global average temperature in 2023 was 14.98 degrees Celsius. This is 0.17 degrees Celsius more than the global average temperature of 2016.


