### History of 10 March

- ◆ **1922** : Mahatma Gandhi was arrested on charges of treason.
- ◆ **1897** : Inspiration for women's education, social worker and famous poet Sonia Bard Phule passed away.
- ◆ **1922** : Nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty was signed by China.
- ◆ **2010** : Women leftists became independent in the Rajya Sabha, the upper house of the Indian Parliament.
- ◆ **2003** : North Korea tested a cruise missile.

### Current Affairs Related to 10 March

- ◆ **Operation Kamdhenu** has been started by Jammu and Kashmir Police. To curb the issue of cattle smuggling, Jammu and Kashmir Police launched Operation Kamdhenu. A comprehensive strategy will be prepared to check the activities of animal smugglers. Its main objective is not only to tackle smuggling activities but also to catch the masterminds behind these illegal activities. Additionally, the assets of the accused will be assessed as part of the investigation process. Under this operation, engine and chassis numbers, mobile numbers and Aadhaar card details of the vehicles involved in smuggling will be documented.
- ◆ **Karnataka and World Economic Forum** join hands to set up a center for Artificial Intelligence. It will be part of the World Economic Forum's Center for the Fourth Industrial Revolution. This center will play an important role in establishing industry academic networks and facilitating exchange of technological trends. It will also help in promoting research collaboration and responding actively to global issues. Its main goals are to contribute to the global conversation on the ethical and practical dimensions of AI.
- ◆ **Infibeam Avenues**, India's leading fintech company and the country's first listed unit in this sector, has achieved an important milestone. Reserve Bank of India granted final authorization to Infibeam Avenue to act as a pay aggregator under its renowned pay gateway brand, CCAvenue. This development is released after Scientist Sagar in October 2022.
- ◆ **Central government** gave big relaxation to central employees. In fact, this year the Shanghai Batcha has been increased from a fixed 46 percent to 50% of the basic pay by the Centre. This will benefit more than one crore employees and pensioners. Union Minister Piyush Goyal said after the Secretariat meeting that a demand has been made to compensate for inflation in basic salary/pension.
- ◆ **Shri Piyush Goyal**, Minister of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution, Commerce & Industry and Textiles launched the e-Kisan Upaj Nidhi of Warehouse Central Companies & Regulatory Company in New Delhi. It is set to join India's journey to become a developed nation by early 2047, with agriculture as its foundation pillar. The e-Kisan Subject Fund will first simplify storage logistics for farmers, ensuring that they get price for their produce.
- ◆ **Bengaluru Metro Rail Corporation Limited** has received the first set of six train coaches for its upcoming driverless metro line, called the Yellow Line. This 18.8 km long line connecting RV Road and Bommasandra will be India's first driverless train system. The new metro line uses a communication based train system, which is a modern radio communication system that provides timely and transmission train control information.
- ◆ **As a party to the Convention on International Trade**, India has implemented measures to consider foreign entrepreneurs and endangered communities of flora. The Living Animals Rules 2024 issued by the Union Environment Ministry are aimed at implementing the Convention and ensuring the protection of endangered animal resources. Under these licenses, people who own exotic pets such as macaws, cockatoos or various male shell turtles are required to register them with the State Department.
- ◆ **The Indian Consulate in Dubai** has launched a new insurance scheme for Indian apartments in case of natural and accidental death to provide financial benefits to the remains of the deceased. The embassy organized meetings between major companies and insurance service providers recruiting Indian collar associates for the life protection scheme that can cover accidental and natural death in Blue Food.
